










- Further reporting is being developed to provide decision-makers and the public with regular information without compromising individual confidentiality.




Testing Update

Types of testing





- PCR testing detects virus DNA
- Can identify infection
 before symptoms
- 5,000 kits on order due mid April
- Serology detects body's response to infection
- 50,000 due by mid April, 100,000 to follow
- Island wide testing programme – starting with frontline workers
